With advanced 3D BodyView imaging technology, the new scanner can help the doctor identify postural asymmetries and imbalances that begin with the feet but can cause fatigue and pain in other muscles and joints.

As an expert in the field of bio-mechanics and a chiropractor with over 15 years of experience, Dr. Swistak recognizes that it's critical to identify and treat the underlying causes and not just the obvious symptoms. Now 3D BodyView makes it easier to communicate that important message to his patients. "3D BodyView produces a very accurate 3D volumetric image in true color that enables us to actually show patients levels of asymmetry throughout the body and how they may relate to the feet. This can help us find postural problems that are causing pain in the feet, knees, hips and lower back. Once we understand—and the patient understands—the underlying issues, we can create custom orthotics to address them."

While Dr. Swistak has introduced the new assessment technology to his patients slowly since the beginning of the year, he's already excited about the results he's seeing. "The five to ten patients we've worked with so far have had great results, including a reduction in symptoms and improved balance. My wife and I have also been using them (custom stabilizing orthotics) for several months and have noticed a big difference in how our feet, legs and back feel at the end of the day."

Education is a powerful thing. When people recognize the relationship between their feet and their body's overall alignment, they begin to see how custom orthotics can help. Dr. Swistak explains, "People think orthotics are just for foot problems and don't realize they are good for lower back pain, knee pain and hip pain. Once arches in the feet are compromised, there is no way to restore them. However, research shows that custom orthotics can increase strength and balance. Plus they can even improve the effectiveness of chiropractic adjustments."
